From our Vicar

Dear Friends

Warm greetings in the everlasting name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.!!!

“Revive us again oh! Lord, so your people can rejoice in you.” (Ps: 85:6)

We all know that the Church has entered into another Pentecost season. In a general notion, Pentecost Season indicates the renewal of the Church; therefore, I think it would be fair to share with you a few thoughts about the importance of renewal in Christian Life, this month. Renewed life of a Christian is indivisibly related to the imperatives of New Testament. There are three important concepts in the New Testament in Greek language that expresses profound gospel imperatives. They are ‘Metanoia’ (Repentance-Mark: 1:15) ‘Diakonia’ (Sacrificial Service—Mark: 10:45) and ‘Koinonia’. (Fellowship- John: 17:21) These are very important because these words were directly spoken by our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Each of these imperatives is mutually connected. By renewal and renewed life, we mean a life with new insights, a life with new perspectives and new perceptions, a transformed life. This transformation always starts within the heart and is gradually permeated to the whole personality of life. Let’s see what renewal of life really means.

Once a monk was asked, “What were you used to doing before you became enlightened?” The monk said, “I used to chop wood and carry water from the well.” Then the questioner asked, “What do you do now, after you became enlightened?” The monk politely said, “I chop wood and carry water from the well.” The questioner was puzzled and said, “Then there seems to be no difference.”

Then the monk said, “The difference is not in my work, the difference is in me, I have changed, all my perceptions and actions have changed, their significance too has changed; now there is only God and nothing else”. Renewal is nothing but a change in perceptions and understandings, which is aroused from our inner being and transforms the whole of our personality.

Renewal is possible, only when we expose ourselves to the intervention of God in our lives. It is very clear from the life of prophet Isaiah. (Isaiah: 6:1-11) An exalted view of God brings a clear view of sin and a realistic view of self. A diminished view of God brings a reduced concern for sin and an inflated view of self. Isaiah may have been satisfied with his personal holiness until he saw the Lord in his unspeakable glory. Isaiah’s encounter with Holy God made him change his

perceptions and understandings. We also need such an encounter in our lives to have a change in our perceptions and perspectives in all walks of our life. It will also give us a new insight about the vocation of our life (Diaconia). Meeting with God requires preparation. God is awesome and perfectly holy; coming into His presence unprepared is an affront(Exo:19) God's instruction for preparation is specific, 'Repentance'(Metanoia)involves a complete change of Mind, Will and Behavior and total surrender of our body, mind,

and soul to the will of God. As we are in another Pentecost season, let's repent and submit ourselves to God and He will lead us to the newness of life, which is the abundant life in Christ. (Life in Koinonia: harmonious relationship with God, nature and man).

May the Blessings of God be with you all.

നമ്മുടെ കർത്താവും രക്ഷിതാവുമായ യേശുക്രിസ്തുവിന്റെ നിത്യനാമത്തിൽ ഈ ഷ്മളമായ ആശംസകൾ !!!

'നിന്റെ ജനം നിന്നിൽ ആനന്ദിക്കേണ്ടതിന്നു നീ ഞങ്ങളെ വീണ്ടും ജീവിപ്പിക്കയില്ലയോ?' (സങ്കീ: 85:6)

സഭ മറ്റൊരു പെന്തക്കോസ്ത് കാലത്തിലേക്ക് പ്രവേശിച്ചുവെന്ന് നമുക്കെല്ലാവർക്കും അറിയാം. ഒരു പൊതുധാരണയിൽ, പെന്തക്കോസ്ത് സീസൺ സഭയുടെ നവീകരണത്തെ സൂചിപ്പിക്കുന്നു; അതിനാൽ, ഈ മാസം ക്രിസ്തീയ ജീവിതത്തിൽ നവീകരണത്തിന്റെ പ്രാധാന്യത്തെക്കുറിച്ചുള്ള കുറച്ച് ചിന്തകൾ നിങ്ങളുമായി പങ്കിടുന്നത് ന്യായമാണെന്ന് ഞാൻ കരുതുന്നു. ഒരു ക്രിസ്ത്യാനിയുടെ നവീകരണ ജീവിതം പുതിയ നിയമത്തിന്റെ അനിവാര്യതകളുമായി അവിഭാജ്യമായി ബന്ധപ്പെട്ടിരിക്കുന്നു. ഗ്രീക്ക് ഭാഷയിൽ പുതിയ നിയമത്തിൽ അഗാധമായ സുവിശേഷ ആവശ്യകതകൾ പ്രകടിപ്പിക്കുന്ന മൂന്ന് പ്രധാന ആശയങ്ങളുണ്ട്. അവ 'മെറ്റനോയ' (പശ്ചാത്താപം - മാർക്ക്: 1:15) 'ഡയക്കോ

ണിയ' (ത്യാഗശുശ്രൂഷ - മാർക്ക്: 10:45), 'കൊയ്മനോനിയ' (ഫെല്ലോഷിപ്പ് - ജോൺ: 17:21) എന്നിവയാണ്. ഇവ വളരെ പ്രധാനമാണ്, കാരണം ഈ വാക്കുകൾ നമ്മുടെ കർത്താവും രക്ഷകനുമായ യേശുക്രിസ്തു നേരിട്ട് പറഞ്ഞതാണ്. ഈ അനിവാര്യതകൾ ഓരോന്നും പരസ്പരം ബന്ധപ്പെട്ടിരിക്കുന്നു. നവീകരണവും പുതുക്കിയ ജീവിതവും എന്നതുകൊണ്ട് അർത്ഥമാക്കുന്നത്, പുതിയ ഉൾക്കാഴ്ചകളുള്ള ജീവിതം, പുതിയ കാഴ്ചപ്പാടുകളും പുതിയ ധാരണകളുമുള്ള ജീവിതം, രൂപാന്തരപ്പെട്ട ജീവിതം. ഈ പരിവർത്തനം എല്ലായ്പ്പോഴും ഹൃദയത്തിൽ നിന്ന് ആരംഭിക്കുകയും ക്രമേണ ജീവിതത്തിന്റെ മുഴുവൻ വ്യക്തിത്വത്തിലേക്കും വ്യാപിക്കുകയും ചെയ്യുന്നു. ജീവിതത്തിന്റെ നവീകരണത്തിന്റെ അർത്ഥമെന്താണെന്ന് നോക്കാം.

ഒരിക്കൽ ഒരു സന്യാസിയോട് ചോദിച്ചു, 'താങ്കൾ ബോധോദയം പ്രാപിക്കുന്നതിന് മുമ്പ് എന്താണ് ചെയ്തിരുന്നത്?' സന്യാസി പറഞ്ഞു, 'ഞാൻ വിറകുവെട്ടുകയും കിണറ്റിൽ നിന്ന് വെള്ളം കൊണ്ടുപോകുകയും ചെയ്യുമായിരുന്നു.' അപ്പോൾ

ചോദ്യകർത്താവ് ചോദിച്ചു, 'നിങ്ങൾ ബോധോദയമായതിന് ശേഷം നിങ്ങൾ ഇപ്പോൾ എന്താണ് ചെയ്യുന്നത്?' സന്യാസി വിനയ പൂർവ്വം പറഞ്ഞു, 'ഞാൻ വിറകുവെട്ടുകയും കിണറ്റിൽ നിന്ന് വെള്ളം കൊണ്ടുപോകുകയും ചെയ്യുന്നു.' ചോദ്യകർത്താവ് ആശയക്കുഴപ്പത്തിലായി, 'അപ്പോൾ ഒരു വ്യത്യാസവുമില്ലെന്ന് തോന്നുന്നു.'

അപ്പോൾ സന്യാസി പറഞ്ഞു, 'വ്യത്യാസം എന്റെ ജോലിയിലല്ല, വ്യത്യാസം എന്നിലാണ്, ഞാൻ മാറി, പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങളെക്കുറിച്ചുള്ള എന്റെ എല്ലാ ധാരണകളും മാറി, അവയുടെ പ്രാധാന്യവും മാറി; ഇപ്പോൾ ദൈവം മാത്രമേയുള്ളൂ, മറ്റൊന്നും ഇല്ല. നവീകരണം എന്നത് മറ്റൊന്നുമല്ല, നമ്മുടെ ആന്തരിക സത്തയിൽ നിന്ന് ഉണർന്ന് നമ്മുടെ വ്യക്തിത്വത്തെ മൊത്തത്തിൽ രൂപാന്തരപ്പെടുത്തി നമ്മുടെ ധാരണകളിലെയും വീക്ഷണങ്ങളിലും വരുന്ന മാറ്റം.

നമ്മുടെ ജീവിതത്തിൽ ദൈവത്തിന്റെ ഇടപെടലിലേക്ക് നമ്മെത്തന്നെ തുറന്നു കാട്ടുമ്പോൾ മാത്രമേ നവീകരണം സാധ്യമാകൂ. ഏതൊരു പ്രവാചകന്റെ ജീവിതത്തിൽ നിന്ന് ഇത് വളരെ വ്യക്തമാണ്. (യെശയ്യാവ്: 6:1-11) ദൈവത്തെക്കുറിച്ചുള്ള ഉയർന്ന വീക്ഷണം പാപത്തെക്കുറിച്ചുള്ള വ്യക്തമായ വീക്ഷണവും സ്വയത്തെക്കുറിച്ചുള്ള യാഥാർത്ഥ്യബോധവും നൽകുന്നു. ദൈവത്തെക്കുറിച്ചുള്ള വീക്ഷണം കുറയുന്നത് പാപത്തോടുള്ള ആശങ്ക കുറയുകയും സ്വയം വീക്ഷണം വർദ്ധിപ്പിക്കുകയും ചെയ്യുന്നു. കർത്താവിനെ പറഞ്ഞറിയിക്കാനാവാത്ത മഹത്വത്തിൽ ദർശിക്കുന്നതുവരെ യെശയ്യാവ് തന്റെ വ്യക്തിപരമായ വിശുദ്ധിയിൽ സംതൃപ്തനായിരി

ക്കാം. പരിശുദ്ധ ദൈവവുമായുള്ള യെശയ്യാവിന്റെ കണ്ടുമുട്ടൽ അവന്റെ ധാരണകളിലും വീക്ഷണങ്ങളിലും മാറ്റം വരുത്തി. നമ്മുടെ ജീവിതത്തിന്റെ എല്ലാ മേഖലകളിലും നമ്മുടെ ധാരണകളിലും വീക്ഷണങ്ങളിലും മാറ്റം വരാൻ നമ്മുടെ ജീവിതത്തിലും അന്തരമൊരു കണ്ടുമുട്ടൽ ആവശ്യമാണ്. ഇത് നമ്മുടെ ജീവിതത്തിന്റെ (ഡയക്കോണിയ) തൊഴിലിനെക്കുറിച്ചുള്ള ഒരു പുതിയ ഉൾക്കാഴ്ചയും നൽകും. ദൈവവുമായുള്ള കൂടിക്കാഴ്ചയ്ക്ക് തയ്യാറെടുപ്പ് ആവശ്യമാണ്. ദൈവം മഹത്വവും തികഞ്ഞ പരിശുദ്ധനുമാണ്; തയ്യാറാകാതെ അവന്റെ സന്നിധിയിൽ വരുന്നത് ഒരു അപമാനമാണ് (പുറം: 19) തയ്യാറെടുപ്പിനുള്ള ദൈവത്തിന്റെ നിർദ്ദേശം നിർദ്ദിഷ്ടമാണ്, 'പശ്ചാത്താപം' (മറ്റൊന്നോ) മനസ്സിന്റെയും ഇച്ഛയുടെയും പെരുമാറ്റത്തിന്റെയും പൂർണ്ണമായ മാറ്റവും നമ്മുടെ ശരീരത്തിന്റെയും മനസ്സിന്റെയും ആത്മാവിന്റെയും പൂർണ്ണമായ കീഴടങ്ങലും ഉൾപ്പെടുന്നു. നാം മറ്റൊരു പെന്തക്കോസ്ത് സീസണിലായതിനാൽ, നമുക്ക് അനൂതപിച്ച് ദൈവത്തിന് സ്വയം സമർപ്പിക്കാം, അവൻ നമ്മെ ജീവിതത്തിന്റെ പുതുക്കിയ ലേക്ക് നയിക്കും, അത് ക്രിസ്തുവിലുള്ള സമൃദ്ധമായ ജീവിതമാണ്. (കൊയ്നോനിയയിലെ ജീവിതം: ദൈവം, പ്രകൃതി, മനുഷ്യൻ എന്നിവയുമായുള്ള യോജിപ്പുള്ള ബന്ധം). ദൈവാനുഗ്രഹം നിങ്ങൾക്കെല്ലാവർക്കും ഉണ്ടാകട്ടെ.
